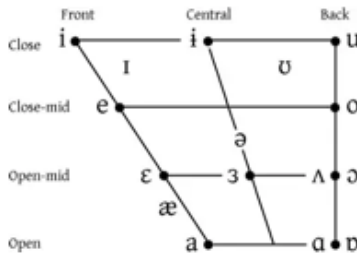




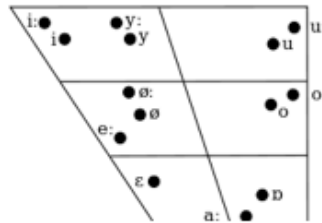

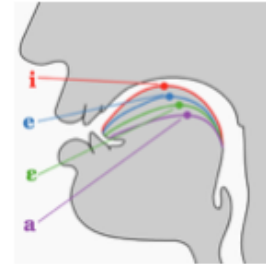

The chart above shows the International Phonetics Chart (IPA) of the location our tongues are in to form the vowel sounds. The English on the left and the Hungarian in the center. First, notice the many extra dots of the Hungarian, second notice the many different places the dots are indicating the different location our tongue needs to be to sound Hungarian. I have never been shown this in all of my Hungarian lessons. Basically, I have had the wrong information to understanding how to speak Hungarian!
